ORDER:

The Director of Collegiate Education has forwarded the application submitted by the Pioneer Trust, Coimbatore to open an unaided Private College in the name of Pioneer College of Arts and Science, Jothipuram, Perianaickenpalayan, Coimbatore. The Director of Collegiate Education has stated that the management has provided the following:

i) An Endowment of Rs.20/- lakhs (Rupees twenty lakhs only) has been created in the joint name of Director of Collegiate Education and Pioneer Trust with the Tamil Nadu Power Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited.

ii) The Management has leased 15 acres of land at Jothipuram Perianaickenpalayan Village, Coimbatore for 51 years in Survey Nos. 397, 387, 388 and 396 (part).

iii) Agreement in stamp paper to abide by all conditions prescribed by the Government.

2) The Government have examined the proposal carefully and they permit Pioneer Trust, Coimbatore to open a Self-financing Arts and Science College in the name and style of Pioneer College of Arts and Science, Jothipuram, Perianaickenpalayan, Coimbatore with the following courses from the academic year 1998-99.

- i) B.Sc., Computer Science
- ii) B.Com., and
- iii) B.B.A.,

3) The management is permitted to start the college during 1998-99 temporarily at the rented G.P.Arivarangan building owned by the Higher Education Secondary School, run by the Pioneer Mills Limited and it should be shifted to the permanent building during 1999-2000 to be constructed in the land mentioned in para 1(ii) above.
